

TextBehindImg.com — SEO Audit & 30-Day Growth Plan

Auditor's lens: Senior Google Search engineer. **Goal:** Maximum organic gain in 30 days, white-hat only. **Date:** June 30, 2026.

The one-sentence truth

You have a working product ranking at **average position 7.5 for "text behind image" (15,994 impressions/quarter)** and the entire rest of the cluster also at position 6–8 — which means **you are stuck at the bottom of page 1 for almost everything**, your homepage is your only real asset, your blog is empty, you have no backlink program, and you're losing the on-page CTR game. Everything below is about pushing that cluster from **position ~7 → 3–4** and capturing the long-tail you already get impressions for. Nothing here is branding fluff.

Read this carefully: "text behind image" alone is **15,994 impressions at 1.6% CTR**. The expected CTR for position 7–8 is roughly 3–4%. You're getting **less than half** the clicks your own ranking should deliver. That's a pure on-page/SERP-appearance problem you can fix this week. Then there's a second, larger prize: moving from 7.5 to 4 roughly triples click share; to 3 roughly 5x's it.

Math on the realistic 30-day ceiling:

- Fix CTR to position-appropriate ~4% on existing impressions → ~254 → ~640 clicks/qtr from the head term alone, **no ranking change required**.
- Move the cluster from 7.5 → ~4.5 over the month → impressions and CTR both climb; realistic blended outcome is **2–3x total clicks** (743 → ~1,800–2,200/qtr run-rate) if links + content + CWV all land.

Why you're stuck at position 7 (brutally honest)

1. **Domain disadvantage you can't change.** The query is "text behimage." Your competitors are textbehindimage.com, text-behind-image.org, textbehindimage.net, .studio — **exact-match** for the spelled-out phrase. You abbreviate to "img." Google gives a small but real relevance nudge to exact-match domains for this head term. **You cannot out-domain them, so you must out-content, out-link, and out-engage them.** This is the whole strategy.
2. **One page doing all the work.** Your blog is literally empty ("Welcome to our blog," 41 words, zero posts). The #1 competitor (text-behind-image.org) ranks partly because it has **targeted guide posts** ("text behind image for Instagram," "...in CapCut," "...YouTube thumbnail") dated this month, internally linked from the homepage. You have impressions for those exact intents ([text behind image instagram](#)-type, [text behind image youtube](#), [add text behind image](#)) and **no page to catch them.**
3. **No backlink program.** The same competitor is listed on ~12 AI-tool directories (findly.tools, dang.ai, saasfame, toolfame, aidirs, fazier, ToolRain, etc.) — visible as badge links in their footer. That's cheap, white-hat authority you currently lack.
4. **Self-inflicted CTR loss.** Title is 83 characters and meta description 209 characters — **both truncate in the SERP**, so your snippet is cut off and weaker than it should be.
5. **Ads above the content on a page fighting for top 3.** You load Google AdSense ([doubleclick](#), [googlesyndication](#)) — which adds layout shift (CLS) and INP/LCP cost — on the exact page you need to be lightning-fast and stable to win. Worse, **your own FAQ says "no advertisements" while the page serves ads** — a factual contradiction Google's quality systems and users both notice.
6. **21 language pages with zero hreflang.** You have [/de/](#), [/es/](#), [/fr/](#)... [/ar/](#), [/hi/](#), etc., all properly translated — but **no hreflang anywhere** (not in head, not in sitemap) and **no lastmod** in the sitemap. Google can't connect them, may serve the wrong-language URL, and may treat them as competing near-duplicates.

Technical SEO — findings

Good (don't touch):

- [robots.txt](#) clean, allows all, points to sitemap. ✓

- Canonicals are self-referential and correct. ✓
- `meta robots: index, follow, max-image-preview:large` ✓
- Valid structured data already present: **WebSite, WebApplication, HowTo, FAQPage** ✓ (this is a real asset — most competitors have less)
- Viewport set, `lang="en"`, HTTPS, fast TTFB (~300ms), light HTML, all images have alt text. ✓

Problems, by severity:

The 30-day plan — prioritized by ROI (highest first)

Rule: do the **zero-ranking-required CTR fixes first** (instant), then the **content + internal links** (compounds over the month), then **backlinks** (lifts the whole domain), with **CWV + hreflang** in parallel.

TIER 1 — This week. Instant CTR, no ranking change needed.

1A. Rewrite the title tag (≤60 chars). Lead with the exact head term.

1B. Rewrite the meta description (≤155 chars), front-load the benefit + a CTA verb.

1C. Ship a **WebApplication/SoftwareApplication rating + offer block** so a price ("Free") and, if you can legitimately collect them, aggregate ratings show in the SERP. You already output WebApplication JSON-LD — extend it:

Only add **aggregateRating** if you have genuine user ratings — fabricated ratings are a manual-action risk. White-hat: add a simple thumbs-up/star widget and accumulate real ones.

1D. Verify FAQ & HowTo JSON-LD match visible on-page text (Google requires the markup to match what users see). You have both — just confirm every Q in the schema exists verbatim on the page.

Expected effect of Tier 1: CTR on 35K impressions moves from 2.1% → ~3.5–4%. That's roughly **+250–350 clicks/quarter run-rate within days of recrawl**, before any ranking improvement.

TIER 2 — Days 2–14. Content that catches the long-tail you already rank for.

Your blog is empty. The competitor's guide posts are why they out-rank you on intent queries. Publish **5 focused guides**, each 900–1,400 words, each targeting a query you already have impressions for, each internally linked from the homepage and to the tool.

Write these in priority order (by existing impression demand):

1. **"How to Put Text Behind a Subject in a YouTube Thumbnail (Free)"** → targets **text behind image youtube**, thumbnail intent. Highest commercial value.
2. **"How to Add Text Behind Your Photo for Instagram Stories & Posts"** → **text behind photo, add text behind image**.
3. **"Text Behind Image in Photoshop vs. a Free AI Tool (Step-by-Step)"** → captures the "expensive software" comparison query; FAQ already references Photoshop.
4. **"Image Behind Text vs. Text Behind Image: What's the Difference?"** → **image behind text** (223 impr, pos 8.5 — you're barely ranking; own it).
5. **"How to Put Text Behind an Image in CapCut (+ Faster Free Alternative)"** → mobile/video-editor intent the competitor already monetizes.

Each post must contain:

- The exact target query in the H1, first 100 words, and one H2.
- 2–4 real screenshots with keyword-bearing alt text.
- A **HowTo** JSON-LD block (you already have the pattern).

- A `BreadcrumbList` JSON-LD.
- A strong internal link to the homepage tool ("create it free here") and to 1–2 sibling guides.
- `Article` schema with `datePublished` and `dateModified`.

Then: add a "Guides" section on the homepage linking to all 5 (mirror the competitor's "Popular Text-Behind-Image Guides" block). This passes homepage authority to the new posts and builds a topical cluster.

Fix the blog index at the same time: real H1 ("Text Behind Image Guides & Tutorials"), intro paragraph with the keyword, and the post grid. Add all posts (and the blog index) to the sitemap with `<lastmod>`.

TIER 3 — Days 3–21 (run in parallel). Backlinks — the lever that lifts position.

This is the single biggest factor keeping you at 7 instead of 3. The competitor's footer reveals their exact white-hat playbook: **niche AI-tool & startup directories**. Replicate it. These are free, legitimate, and indexable.

Submit TextBehindImg to (one per day, ~30 min each):

- Product Hunt (you have a PH link already — make sure the listing is live and optimized)
- There's An AI For That (theresanaiforthat.com)
- Futurepedia, Toolify.ai, Altoolsdirectory, Future Tools
- dang.ai, findly.tools, aidirs, saasfame, toolfame, ToolRain, Fazier launch
- AlternativeTo (list as an alternative to Canva / Photoshop for this effect)
- Relevant subreddits & forums **only where genuinely useful** (e.g., answer a real "how do I put text behind a subject" question and link the tool — no spam).

Target: **15–25 directory/citation links in 3 weeks**. None are spammy; all are the standard white-hat launch circuit. This is the fastest legitimate way to move a low-authority niche domain up a few positions.

Also: add the directory badges to your footer (reciprocal, expected in this niche) and reach out to 3–5 "best free design tools" listicle authors offering your tool — these editorial links are the highest-value ones.

TIER 4 — Days 7–21 (parallel). Core Web Vitals & UX.

Your HTML is light and TTFB is good, so **ads are your main CWV liability** on the money page.

1. **Reserve ad slot height** to kill CLS: every ad container gets a fixed `min-height`/aspect-ratio so content doesn't jump.

2. **Lazy-load below-the-fold ads** and **defer the AdSense script** so it doesn't block LCP/INP:

Don't place an ad above or beside the upload/editor — the tool is the LCP element and the reason people land.

3. **Remove the first ad unit above the fold** entirely on the homepage. A page trying to reach top 3 for a transactional tool query should let users hit the tool instantly. Move ads below the editor.
4. **Resolve the "no advertisements" contradiction.** Either remove that FAQ claim (recommended — it's false) or remove the ads. Mismatched claims hurt trust and quality scoring.
5. Confirm `width/height` on all `` (you have alt text; ensure dimensions are set to prevent shift), and `loading="lazy"` on below-fold images, `fetchpriority="high"` on the LCP/hero image.
6. Run PageSpeed Insights for the live mobile field data and confirm LCP < 2.5s, INP < 200ms, CLS < 0.1 after the ad changes.

TIER 5 — Days 5–20 (parallel). International / hreflang.

You have 21 translated pages earning nothing because Google can't map them. Add reciprocal hreflang to **every** page in the set (each page lists all alternates + `x-default`).

Rules: the set must be **reciprocal** (every page references every other, including itself) and use correct codes (**zh-cn**→**zh-Hans**, **zh-tw**→**zh-Hant**, **pt**→**pt/pt-br** as appropriate). Add **<lastmod>** to the sitemap for all of them. This unlocks non-English impressions that currently leak.

Day-by-day execution calendar

Week 1 — instant wins + content engine starts

- **Day 1:** Title + meta rewrite (1A/1B). Extend WebApplication schema (1C). Validate FAQ/HowTo match (1D). Request indexing in GSC.
- **Day 2:** Fix blog index page; add **<lastmod>** to sitemap. Draft + publish **Guide #1 (YouTube thumbnail)**. Add homepage "Guides" section linking it.
- **Day 3:** Publish **Guide #2 (Instagram)**. Submit to Product Hunt + There's An AI For That.
- **Day 4:** Publish **Guide #3 (Photoshop comparison)**. Submit to Futurepedia + Toolify.
- **Day 5:** Hreflang block built and deployed to all 21 + root (Tier 5). Submit to dang.ai + findly.tools.
- **Day 6:** Publish **Guide #4 (image behind text)**. Submit to Fazier + aidirs.
- **Day 7:** Publish **Guide #5 (CapCut)**. Run PageSpeed Insights baseline. Submit to AlternativeTo.

Week 2 — CWV + links + interlinking

- **Day 8:** Ad changes: reserve slot heights, remove above-fold ad, defer script (Tier 4).
- **Day 9:** Resolve "no ads" copy; re-test CLS/INP.
- **Day 10:** Internal-link pass — every guide links to 2 siblings + the tool; homepage links to all guides.
- **Day 11–12:** Submit to saasfame, toolfame, ToolRain, Future Tools, Altoolsdirectory (1/day). Add badges to footer.
- **Day 13:** Outreach to 3 "best free design tools" listicle authors.
- **Day 14:** GSC check — recrawl status, CTR movement on head term, validate rich results.

Week 3 — expand content + finish links

- **Day 15–17:** Publish 2 more guides from the next-tier queries ([text behind image free](#), [text behind image editor](#), [create text behind image](#)). Keep interlinking.
- **Day 18–20:** Finish remaining directory submissions; 3 more listicle outreaches; submit updated sitemap.
- **Day 21:** Full rich-results + hreflang validation (GSC International Targeting / Rich Results Test).

Week 4 — measure, double down, iterate

- **Day 22–25:** In GSC, pull queries that moved into positions 4–8 with rising impressions; update those exact pages' titles/H1s/first-paragraph to match the winning query precisely. Add an FAQ answer for any new question-style query that appeared.
 - **Day 26–28:** Refresh [dateModified](#) on all guides (freshness), add 1–2 internal links from the highest-traffic guide to weaker ones.
 - **Day 29:** Re-run PageSpeed; confirm CWV green on mobile.
 - **Day 30:** Compare to Day-0 GSC baseline: total clicks, avg position on the cluster, CTR on "text behind image." Decide next month's content from the new striking-distance list.

What NOT to do (would waste your 30 days)

- Don't buy links, use PBNs, or fabricate ratings — manual-action risk, kills everything.
- Don't rebrand or chase a new domain — too slow, and you'd lose the position-7 equity you have.
- Don't spin up dozens of thin pages — Google's helpful-content systems punish it; 5–7 genuinely useful guides beat 50 thin ones.
- Don't keep an ad above the editor to chase pennies while losing the ranking that funds everything.

The single highest-ROI action if you only do one thing

Rewrite the title + meta today and remove the above-the-fold ad. It requires no new content and no links, takes an hour, and recovers clicks you're currently leaving on the table across 35,000 impressions — while making the page faster and more trustworthy for the ranking climb everything else drives.
